


Registry Permissions

It is not necessary to run the Call Accounting application as a user with Administrator rights in Windows. The application does update the registry settings on the PC so the user must have permission to make changes to the registry. Use the steps below to ensure that the application has the correct permissions and can operate normally.

1. The Registry Editor allows an Administrator to change the security settings for a particular user (or group of users). From the **Start Menu** select the **Run** option and enter **Regedt32.exe**.



2. Locate the registry key used by the Call Accounting Application. Select the **Edit | Permissions...** option from the menu to display the Permissions dialog. (\\HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Metropolis(+Wow6432Node if 64-bit))



3. Specify the User (or group of Users) you wish to allow access and click the **Full Control** checkbox under the **Allow** column. Click OK.
